

Charter SELPA Application Appeal Process

After review and revision of the Charter Application Matrix, point values will be assigned to each category. A minimum/or passing score will be established for each category.

The Matrix, point values and minimum score will be published on the Charter SELPA website along with the application.

Charter schools will be informed of their score with their rejection notification.

If a charter school feels they have evidence or compelling information that may alter their score, they may submit new information to the CEO Selection Committee within two weeks of notification of their rejection.

Only those schools whose initial score was within ten points of the minimum score for each category will be considered for review.

The CEO Selection Committee will review the “new” information and, at that point, determine if the committee will meet with the charter school to hear an appeal.
